

ACCSC DISCLOSURE OF COMMISSION ACTION SUMMARY OF GROUNDS FOR WARNING ACTION

The Accrediting Commission of Career School and Colleges has issued a Warning to Aviator College of Aeronautical Science & Technology located in Fort Pierce, Florida. Pursuant to ACCSC's *Rules of Process and Procedure*, the Commission will publish a summary of the reasons for the Warning. The school has an opportunity to submit a response to demonstrate corrective action regarding the Commission's grounds for the Warning.

- 1. Aviator College of Aeronautical Science & Technology must demonstrate that the school has adequate ownership, management, and administrative capacity in place that includes:
 - a. Full-time on-site supervision by an individual or team with the appropriate combination of education, experience, and demonstrated ability to lead and manage a post-secondary educational institution in compliance with accrediting standards;
 - b. Owners, board members, members of school management, and administrative employees who are qualified for their particular roles and who possess the appropriate education, training, and experience commensurate with the level of their responsibilities;
 - c. A sufficient number of managers and administrative employees necessary to support the school's operations, student services, and educational programs; and
 - d. Appropriate administrative and operational policies and procedures to which the school adheres, reviews, and updates as needed.

(Section I (A)(a-d), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation)

- 2. Aviator College of Aeronautical Science & Technology must demonstrate that the school's student services program adequately encompasses student safety and well-being (Section VI (A)(3)(b), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation) and that the school's written Emergency Preparedness Plan includes appropriate emergency scenario identification and concordant action plans (Section I (G)(3), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation).
- 3. Aviator College of Aeronautical Science & Technology must demonstrate that all machinery and equipment is properly maintained and provided with proper safety devices, which are in working order and used whenever the machinery and equipment is operated (*Section II (A)(5)(d), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation*).
- 4. Aviator College of Aeronautical Science & Technology must demonstrate that the school's physical facilities are sufficient to create an effective and suitable learning environment (e.g., resources, safety, etc.) (Section I (G)(2), Substantive Standards, Standards of Accreditation).
